Executives Report:

- Lucy welcomed the newcomers to our meeting and gave a quick overview of what we do.
- Lucy also gave annual report for 2022. She discussed the successes of our P&C, not just with fundraising efforts, but also with building and strengthening our community.
- Discussed events planned for the coming weeks and next term.

Principal's Report:

- Karen Wardlaw provided a quick overview of school focus:
 - PBL reframing is being launched. Respect, Safety and Kindness are primary focus
 - Plan updates encouraging parent involvement in their kids learning
 - Big school refurbishment happening this year
 - Launched the attendance program

- K – 2 new curriculum has been introduced. Next term sessions to be made available to parents for discussion of the new curriculum.
- Improvement of school systems, more efficient, better financial systems. 97% of families have downloaded the portal
- Snapshot “plan on a page”, will be shared outlining student growth, wellbeing and capacity, quality teaching
- Focus on Community Engagement
- Spoke to vacant positions and positions being filled
- PBL values are being looked out and revamped to reflect shared values and expectations. Establish values that help drive expectations
- Tech team is being established to help align and work with BYOD. Communication online, offering more parent forums

Uniform Shop Report:

- Back to School Vouchers have made a big difference to income this term, believe we will see a boost in sales just before expiry in June 2023
- Need volunteers to help our a couple hours a week
- Will hold a second-hand stall in Term 2
